Dear Vice President Hatcher,

We act for Voice of Horticulture (**VoH**) in this matter, which we confirm by way of our [attached](#) Form F53 Notice of representative commencing to act.

We refer to the above matter and the Commission's decision dated 9 August 2018 in which it allowed the parties to file further submissions within 21 days of the Commission issuing its Draft Determination. In this respect, the deadline for parties to file any further submissions is 20 September 2018.

Relevantly, the NFF requested an extension of time until 11 October 2018 to file its submissions, which was granted by the Commission by way of correspondence dated 17 September 2018.
