We act for Gymnastics Australia in the above proceeding and refer to the revised exposure draft of the *Fitness Industry Award 2015* published on 29 July 2016.

We understand that this revised exposure draft was intended to contain all amendments agreed by the parties in accordance with the Report to the Full Bench dated 3 June 2016. At Item 16 of that Report, it was set out that " *it is agreed to vary classifications to better reflect the nature of work performed by gymnastics coaches as contained in Gymnastics Australia's submissions of 12 November 2015.*"

The variations to the classification contained in Gymnastics Australia's submissions of 12 November 2015 do not appear to have been reflected at Schedule A of the revised Exposure Draft. We are accordingly writing to clarify whether this was an oversight in the preparation of the revised Exposure Draft or if it is the intent of the Commission to not make the variations agreed.

We look forward to receiving any clarification you can provide.
